Monographic Services Division

July 1, 2011 - June 30, 2012

1. Major activities, accomplishments, significant changes and issues, grants and gifts

Implemented UW versions of the BIBCO Standard Record (BSR) for additional bibliographic formats: moving images, sound recordings, scores, maps, graphic materials, and electronic resources.

Conducted webinars for catalogers and other staff on the FRBR model and on Resource Description and Access (RDA) in preparation for implementing RDA.

Began a pilot of electronic theses and dissertations, including changes in workflow and training.

Participated in the Orbis Cascade Demand Driven Acquisitions e-book pilot, including cataloging of purchased titles.

Cataloged maps on a grant from the Friends of the Libraries.

Contributed to plans for a shared ILS system for the Orbis Cascade Alliance by participating in vendor demos.

Reviewed local practices in light of a shared ILS, including bibliographic mandates adopted by the Orbis Cascade Alliance Council. Changed from a single-record approach for electronic resources to multiple records, in accord with Alliance policy.

Began regular uploading of detailed holdings for multipart items to OCLC.

Loaded 197,217 records for electronic and microform sets into the catalog.

Began planning for reorganization of the division at the end of the fiscal year. Monographic Services ceased to exist on June 30, 2012: the Monographic Acquisitions Section became part of Acquisitions and Rapid Cataloging Services, and the three cataloging sections together with the Database Management Section became part of Cataloging and Metadata Services.

2. Major activities and initiatives anticipated for next year

Monographic Services has no planned activities for fiscal 2012/13 because the unit no longer exists. Staff of the former division will be busy with reorganization, implementation of RDA, and planning for migration of the ILS, among other things.
