

Printing in Odegaard Library

How do I send my print job?

Choose OUGL Commons Dawg Prints (1-sided or 2-sided) as the printer.

How do I pay for my print job?

Use your Husky Card to pay for your print job. You can add cash to your card at the Add-Value Station on the first floor or use your credit or debit card to add money at http://hfs.washington.edu/husky_card/. Funds added will be available immediately.

How do I release my print job?

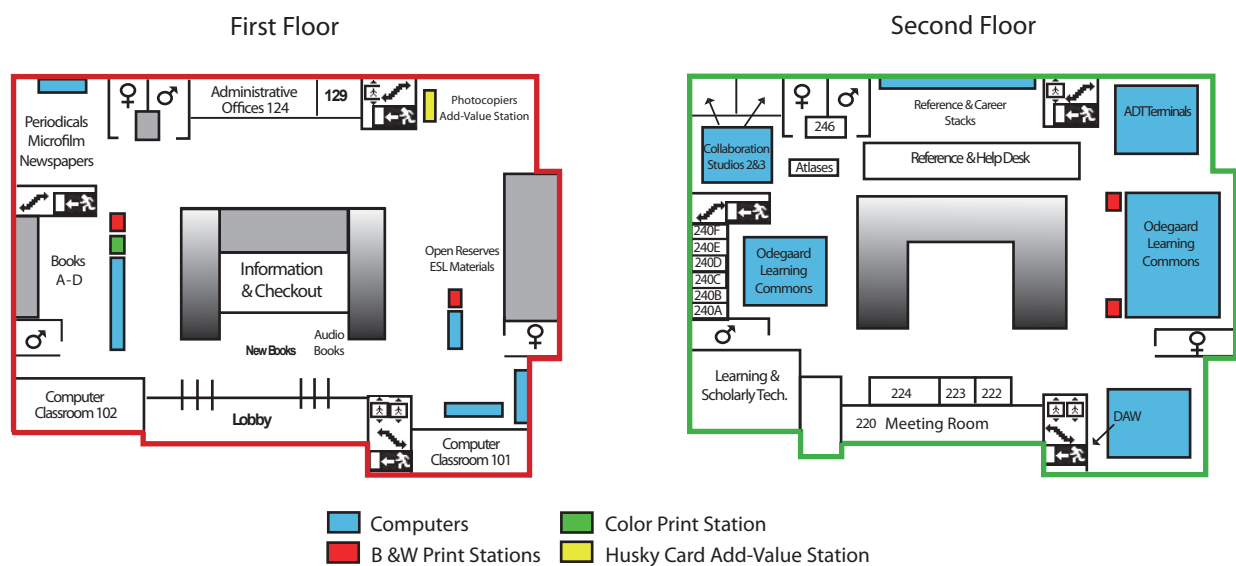
You can release your print jobs sent to the Odegaard and Odegaard Color queues by going to any of the self-serve Printer Stations located in the library. Swipe your card, select your job from the list and click print.

Can I print from my laptop?

Yes. You will first need to download the drivers from <http://www.dawg-prints.com>. Click on the wireless printing tab.

How do I print color, posters, and other special jobs?

Send color prints to the printer called OUGL Color. Release your job at the color printer located on the south side of the building on the first floor. Posters and other special jobs can be printed at the help desk on the second floor or at the Communications Dawg Prints Center (Communications B-042).
