Mark Reed (1866-1933) was a Republican state legislator and president of Simpson Logging Company, as well as Phoenix Logging Company, Reed Mill Company and other business enterprises in Washington State, primarily in Mason County.

Notes on Arrangement

PERSONAL PAPERS: the general correspondence is mostly Reed's political correspondence and general correspondence of Simpson Logging Company, including the correspondence of other Simpson Executives such as A. B. Govey, G. L. Drake and G. W. Ingham. Included also is a small quantity of general correspondence regarding Reed's other businesses.

The SIMPSON LOGGING COMPANY subgroup consists only of Inter-office correspondence of Simpson executives.

The other subgroups all represent businesses which Reed owned or headed.
