#### GAIU - HB168 - P.E.R.C. Folder

Correspondence documenting the transition from an informal labor organization of the University of Washington Print Plant employees to a formal union with collective bargaining rights. Correspondence spans the years of 1973 through 1985.

#### PRESSROOM Folder

Documentation of salary negotiations for University of Washington Press Room employees and the introduction of the Graphic Communications International Union, Local 747-M. File includes contractual agreements, labor cost calculation sheets, and correspondence spanning the years of 1983 to 1986.

## **BINDERY Folder**

Documentation of salary analysis for University of Washington Bindery employees and adjustments as directed by GAIU (Graphic Arts International Union.) File includes correspondence and calculation sheets spanning the years of 1982 through 1985.

## **NW 99 (TYPOGRAPHICAL) Folder**

Documentation of transition from an industry standard of craft status for typographers and union representation by the Northwest Typographical Union No. 99 to automation and serious reduction in staff for University of Washington typographers.
