Walter B. Beals was a member of the Supreme Court of Washington in 1946. At the same time he was granted the position of Presiding Judge at the International Military Tribunal in Nuremburg for Case Number One, the "Doctors" trial.

The material inventoried with accession number 126 came in several installments from the original gift of Beals' papers to the University. All material concerning Nuremburg that could easily be extracted from later accessions has been drawn together and listed here. Later accessions were not processed to the item level as the first one was, which will explain the uneven treatment represented by the inventory. The attached "Additional comments" are those of the original processor of the first installment.

Additional comments:

I have gone through the entire collection of Nuremberg documents in the Manuscripts Collection. It was determined after studying the bound set in the Law Library, that we have a complete set of the Nuremberg Transcript (although it has not been put in order) and a complete set of IMT Case Number 1. These are scattered throughout Boxes 7-58. Cases 2-10 are only represented by partial transcripts. Also Case Number 1 has the complete set of prosecution and defense document books. Some of these are duplicated in German. After I determined that we had a similar but less complete set of the proceedings, I went through each box in search of office files, correspondence, etc. I am certain that I weeded out all that was there. This is organized in Boxes 1-6.

At present a bound set of legal books, abridgements of the proceedings Case 1 through 10 are stored in the Sub-basement under the title Trials of War Criminals, Vols. I - XIII. The proceedings against the main war criminals, Goering, Hess, etc., were used to establish precedent for the various trials to follow.

Box 7-58 have not been actually processed. It was determined to be an unnecessary task. The University of Washington Law Library has a complete bound set of all the Nuremberg proceedings. (Transcripts of all trials, document books, both prosecution and defense, and judgments.) The Librarian will direct you to the collection if you so choose to make use of it.

In Box 8 of this collection, you will find some prosecution document books with illustrations and photographs concerning Nazi experiments. These are not duplicated in the Law Library. In most cases, Beals kept the "original" document books and had mimeographed copies sent to the various institutions requesting them. (The actual originals are in the National Archives.)
