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Iverson Papers. 1908 - 1919 (1898-1936)

Peter Iverson (1861-), state senator (1913-1919), newspaper
Washington. 3 feet. editor, Kitsap Co.,

Iverson was born in Hardanger, Norway in 1861, migrated to
United States in 1881. Arrived in Poulsbo ca. 1899-1900, via Fort
Dodge, Iowa. Married (1886) Josephine Fleming. Edited Kitsap
County Herald from 1900 to 1936 (sold to Nels Gregerson in 1936);
elected State Legislature as Republican, served two terms, 1913-19,
mayor of Poulsbo.

Correspondence concentrated in period ~~1915-1920~~ also concentra-
ted in 1915 and 1919. Papers include financial miscellany; legal
documents; legislative bills; newspapers and clippings; petitions;
reports; speeches and writings; also three volumes of legislative
scrapbooks containing bills submitted to the State Senate, and one
volume containing the State Financial Report for 1918.

Correspondence is concerned primarily with bills before the
Legislature, e.g., Prohibition; direct marketing; logged-off lands;
fisheries (prohibition of aliens from Puget Sound waters, trap
fishing, etc.); direct primary; compulsory vaccination for animals, etc.
Correspondence with James Wesley Bryan deals with Progressive Party
movement in the State.
