CONTAINER LIST

When received, most of the Alice Franklin Bryant accession was not arranged in any perceptible order. Correspondence, clippings, political campaign material etc., covering a span of years from ca. 1915 to 1977, was boxed together. Since some of the material acquired from Bryant was already arranged chronologically in letterboxes, without regard for form (or record series) it was decided to temporarily arrange the remainder of the material chronologically also, excluding some record series, such as address and daybooks, financial records, and audio visual materials, and subject files which were labeled. Although this is not a very satisfactory arrangement, because it does not differentiate the various forms of material represented, it was the quickest means of gaining rudimentary control.

Since Bryant's previously established chronological arrangement, housed in letterboxes, is not integrated with our chronological series, it is necessary for the user to consult both chronological series for each span of years.

1-39 Letterboxes 1946-72
Box one contains a folder of biographical materials. (Includes correspondence, clippings, writings, pamphlets, itineraries, membership cards, photographs, etc)

40-54 Correspondence 1915-77
(Boxes 40-43 include correspondence, clippings, periodicals, ephemera etc. from 1915 up to 1957). Later boxes, dated by 2 year spans i.e., 1958-59.

55-56 Writings (mostly undated)

57 Diaries, daybooks, calendars, tapes. (See Oversize Section for records)

58 Financial records, memorabilia, membership cards, address files.

59 Address files and books

60 Subject Files
