### **Biographical Information**

Arthur G. Barnett is a Seattle attorney who worked on civil rights cases. Most of his papers concern his political and civic efforts on behalf of Japanese-Americans before, during and after the evacuation in 1942. Much of his activities were undertaken as chairman of the Seattle Council of Churches and Christian Education's Japanese American Emergency Committee and its Social Welfare Committee. He was also chairman of the Gordon Hirabayashi Defense Committee. Hirabayashi was arrested, tried and convicted for disobeying evacuation orders and violating curfew in a case that was appealed to the U.S. Supreme Court.

Barnett was chairman and a member of the Board of Trustees of the Civic Unity Committee, which was formed in 1944 by the Mayor of Seattle as an unofficial race relations committee. It was superceded in 1964 by the Seattle Human Rights Commission.

In 1936 Barnett was hired as a field worker for the Warren Avenue Project. The Warren Avenue Project was a youth project instigated by the Community Fund's Inter-Agency Committee and guided by a committee composed of local ministers, school principals, Boy Scout leaders, YMCA and YWCA representatives. Its purpose was to provide recreational and educational activities for youth in the Denny Regrade area, which had the highest rate of juvenile delinquency in the city. It received support from the W.P.A. and Seattle Parks Department

#### **Interviews**

Arthur Barnett discussed the Gordon Hirabayashi case in an interview with Delores Goto in 1971. This interview was subsequently transcribed. The 1974 tape recorded interview with Gordon Hirabayashi also discusses the case. This interview also contains Hirabayashi's comments upon the Alien Land Law case of 1924. The last 15 minutes of the tape includes an interview with S. Katsuno. This interview has not been transcribed.

#### **Provenance**

Arthur Barnett donated these papers to the Libraries in many installments between 1971 and 1984. The tape recording of Gordon Hirabayashi's interview with Barnett was donated by Hirabayashi in 1974. The papers were processed in 1991. They measure 8-1/2 cubic inches.
