## CHARLES E. ODEGAARD PAPERS Accession No. 2380-3-77-4

#### GUIDE

This accession of the personal papers of Charles E. Odegaard, President of the University from 1958 to 1973, was received as part of the President's Office Records (Accession 71-34). The latter records, ordered according to the Rand system, included President Odegaard's personal papers as an integral series separate from the series documenting Odegaard's function as President. This collection of personal papers has, with the exception of the General Correspondence and Speeches and Writings series, been processed only to the folder level, although the Rand system of folder headings has been subdivided into the series Conferences and Conventions and Subject Files. Subgroups have been established to reflect President Odegaard's corporate functions outside the University.
