GUIDE

This accession consists mainly of tape recorded interviews conducted by Stephen L. Sanger for his book, Hanford and the Bomb: an Oral History of World War II, Seattle, Living History Press, 1989.

The audio tapes are listed in alphabetical order but could not be arranged in the same order because many tapes contain more than one interview. Sometimes the B sides of several tapes contain one interview, while the A sides were used for another interview. Both microcassettes and regular audio cassettes were used, sometimes for the same interview.

The inventory also lists the number of tapes, their format, the length of the tapes (as described by the tape summary) and whether a summary is available. Summaries for some of the interviews were prepared by an intern from the UW History Department after the tapes were transferred to the Libraries. There are a few discrepancies between the tape summaries and the tapes re: the number and length of tapes.

This accession was given to the Libraries in 1990, processed in 1992 and measures 7-1/2 inches. Stephen Sanger has retained his copyright and rights of the informants are retained by them.
