INVENTORY

Most of the interviews include a release form. Those without release forms are labeled as such and cannot be directly quoted. Generally, those interviews which have been recorded on audio tapes have written transcripts and those recorded on videotape do not have a corresponding transcript. The informants discuss a wide variety of subjects, in particular , the Great Depression, the Second World War and their specific work experiences. In addition, civil rights, women's rights and African-American westward migration are topics of particular interest to the interviewees who are African-American or women. Some of the interviews also include items such as photographs and clippings.
