This collection of Alumni Association records could be called representative of the great variety of activities carried on by the organization, but it is by no means complete. The records date from 1908 to 1972, with the bulk of the materials having been created from about 1927 on. The Association was first organized in 1899, however the earliest documents in these files, excluding the published information, are minutes and copies of the Association's constitution which date back to 1919. This set of minutes is probably complete to 1926. The Association was incorporated in 1937, however the bulk of the minutes of Trustees' meetings are of those held in the late 1960's. The general correspondence retains the original filing order with the exception of the Harris files which have been collated into one alphabetical series. Most of the very routine letters (i.e., those regarding dues, ticket requests, etc.) have been removed from the correspondence files. In the case of the election files only a sample has been retained.

It should be noted that several potential subgroups have been treated as subject files, especially when they were able to be accommodated more easily under one general heading. Thus the various regional and professional clubs of the Association have been grouped under the heading "Alumni Clubs."

In December 1985 the accession was reprocessed, refoldered to eliminate acidic folders, the arrangement sequences perfected, the inventory rewritten to conform to present format, and the data sheet updated and retyped.
