1. A COLLECTION OF BOOKS @1964 B&W 7 min.

Filmed shortly after the completion of the 1963 Suzzallo Library Addition, this film documents the state of the library system at that time.

2. LESSON ON DIPLOMACY 1958 B&W 40 min.

Eighth Session of Model United Nations Conference held April 1958 on the University of Washington campus. Purposes and functions of the M.U.N.; how conferences are organized.

3. PRESIDENTIAL INAUGURATION 1958 B&W 117 min.

The inauguration exercises of Charles E. Odegaard as President of the University of Washington, November 7, 1958, in Meany Hall.

Part One (30 min.) - Academic Processional. Invocation: Stephen F. Bayne, Bishop of the Archdiocese of Olympia. Opening Ceremonies: Dean Markworth. Introductory Remarks: Harold Shefelman. Greetings for the Commonwealth: Albert D. Rosellini, Governor. Introduction of the Guest Speaker: Mr. Shefelman.

Part Two (29 min.) - The Installation Address: Dr. Nathan Pusey, President, Harvard University

Part Three (26 min.) - Interlude music: University Symphony Orchestra, Dr. Stanley Chapple, Conductor. Induction of the President: Dean Markworth, Mr. Shefelman, and Dr. Charles E. Odegaard. (Inaugural Address: See Part Four.) Benediction: Archbishop Connolly. Recessional.

Part Four (32 min.) - Inaugural Address: Dr. Charles E. Odegaard.
