- ◆ [Expanded Academic Index](#): Database indexes 1,500 journals and periodicals.
- ◆ [Google.com](#): This search engine is helpful in finding reviews, quotations, and film-related information. Suggested keywords: movie reviews; film studies; international film; quote: “[your quote here]” (to find film quotations)
- ◆ [LexisNexis](#): This database contains an extensive amount of full-text news and reviews from a wide variety of newspapers and wire services.
- ◆ [Metacritic.com](#): This website compiles film reviews from authoritative critics and publications.
