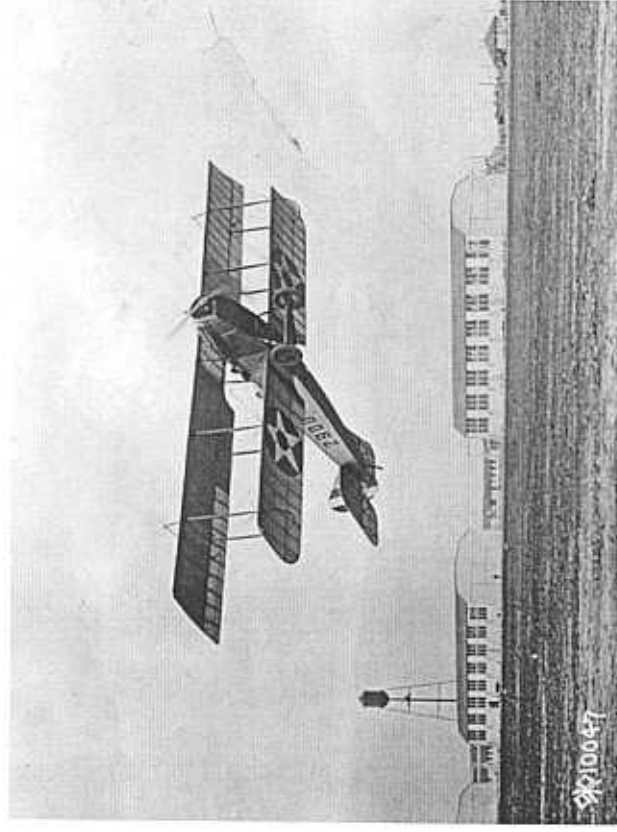


You're a new recruit just shipped out to France. Your task is to discover what everyday life was like on the Western Front. Some questions to explore are:

- What were airplanes like and how did they improve over the course of the war?
- What sorts of training did pilots undergo?
- What role did aviation play in WWI?
