You've been shot down by the Germans and have suffered third-degree burns to your upper body and face. Your task is to discover what sorts of treatment were available to burn victims. Some questions to explore are:

- What was the state of plastic surgery during this time?
- How were facial disfigurements treated?
- What sorts of rehabilitation were available?
- How were burn victims treated once back in civilian life?
