

## Character Obituary

Henry Lewis, a veteran of the First World War and an active civil rights protester, succumbed to lung cancer on Monday, April 3<sup>rd</sup>, 1966 at the age of 71. Lewis made an incredible sacrifice for his country, losing both legs fighting in France in 1918. But he didn't let his disability keep him down, going on to become a bank manager and lifetime member of the NAACP after the war. He was also a strong supporter of Black rights and participated in protests until very recently, when he became too ill to do so. Lewis was an apt role model and was looked up to by all the children in his home neighborhood in Chicago. Lewis is survived by his wife and daughter.
