

While in Chicago you join the anti-lynching crusade initially spearheaded by Ida B. Wells and become a member of the National Association of Colored Women. Your task is to discover more about the anti-lynching campaign in the period between 1915-1925. Some questions to explore are:

- How pervasive was lynching?
- What sorts of laws were there against lynching?
- How did anti-lynching groups attempt to publicize and stop lynching?
- What groups were part of the anti-lynching campaign?

It is 1919 and racial tensions are rising in Chicago. On a hot summer day in July a white man throws stones at a group of African American boys at the beach, a boy drowns and a riot ensues. Your task is to discover more about the Chicago riot of 1919. Some questions to explore are:

- Why did the riot occur? What explanations were given at the time?
- How did White Chicago react? How did Black Chicago react?
- What was the outcome of the riot?
