10:00	<b>Tr. 3</b> – Thomas Bennett continues speaking.
20:00	<b>Tr. 4</b> – Conversation continues
20:37	Loud signal noise; Vi Hilbert interviews Thomas Bennett’s son Thomas Bennett (7 years old) and asks him to say a few words in Tlingit; they trade Lushootseed and Tlingit words; general conversation.
