0:00	Tr. 1 – Stokowski–Konoe: Etenraku (6:27) Note from documentation provided by Robert Garfias: “NHK Symphony with Togi Masataro (Hichiriki) Loibner conducting; aircheck made in Tokyo on New Year’s Day 1959, at 6AM. This is the famous Leopold Stokowski arrangement of Prince Konoe’s original orchestration of the Gagaku piece Etenraku for Western orchestra. They decided to add the hichiriki to give it an air of authenticity. They also broadcast it at 6AM, the beginning of the broadcast day on New Year’s, a time when no one would hear it. I got up and recorded it.”
