0:00	Performer: Muharrem Ertaş, voice and <i>bağlama</i> . Ertaş is a regional performer who lived in Kırşehir, Central Anatolia (he died two years after the interview/recording was conducted – December 1982 in Kırşehir). He is well known for his renditions of the <i>bozlak</i> vocal genre (<i>uzun hava</i> type with lute accompaniment) as performed in the <i>Abdal</i> (ethnic group) style.
