NOTES TO THE ARCHIVIST/INVESTIGATOR FOR THE
THOMPSON RIVER SALISH SLIP FILES

The slip files contained in these two cartons are written on ecru colored ACID FREE PAPER with the exception of the Upper Thompson slip file which is on standard note 4"x6" note cards.

The tissue paper used to package chunks of the files was not ideal but was what we could lay hands on. It serves the immediate purpose but because of its relative delicacy it won't withstand much handling.

The files were kept in an airconditioned space prior to sealing so the moisture content should be relatively low.

In light of the above, until such time as access is granted to an investigator or further archiving action is to be undertaken there is probably no reason to unseal any of the packages.

No file set is divided between cartons.

Each package is wrapped in tissue paper and labeled on all six sides with its package number. To reconstruct the file the packages need only be placed with the first number at the front of the file and the rest in order with the index tabs unfolded.

The slip file sets are packaged individually in plastic bags within the boxes so that any single file can be removed without opening the others in the box. In addition the total contents of the boxes are sealed in plastic.

Each sealed set of file packages has enclosed a list of the contents and a copy of this page.

Each sealed group of files within a carton has a set of lists for all file sets that are sealed in that carton and a copy of this page in the top of the carton outside the outer sealing.

Each carton has the lists of the file sets that it contains in a plastic pouch on the outside of the carton and a copy of this page.

The larger of the two cartons contains:

The Thompson River Salish Dictionary slip file (1 thru 41)
Upper Thompson collected by Sharon Mayes slip file (UT-1 thru UT-5)

The smaller of the two cartons contains the Thompson River Salish slip files of:

Affixes (A1 thru A8)
Lexical Suffixes (LS-1 thru Ls-4)
Roots (R-1 thru R-8)
